## **BAY HILLS BEACHCOMBERS CAMP Summer 2021**

Welcome new BHPOA members and welcome back Beachcombers to our 37<sup>th</sup> season! We're so excited to be back!

Beachcombers is a collaborative effort: the camp was created by the parents in the neighborhood, and it continues to be organized by volunteer Bay Hills parents. We need many helping hands—please try to participate in any way you can.

Camp will run for 7 weeks starting June 28<sup>th</sup>, meeting on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Junior Camp (for 3- and 4-year-olds) takes place from 9:30 a.m.—1:30 p.m., and Senior Camp (for children entering Kindergarten and above) takes place from 9:30 a.m.—2:30 p.m. More detailed descriptions about the camp groups are provided in the enclosed documents.

Beachcombers is open to BHPOA members. The only exception is when a grandparent, a BHPOA member, signs up his or her grandchildren who do not live in Bay Hills. Other relatives or friends are not eligible for camp.

Please note the following:

- **Swim lessons** will be offered and scheduled for every group, but you must indicate that you want your children in lessons on the registration form. If you do not indicate lessons, the children will have a “free swim” period.
- **The CIT group** is for children entering 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades.
- We are continuing the **Senior CIT** program for high-school age kids. The program is intended to provide the children with responsibility in a work-like atmosphere. This is a volunteer position. There is no charge to participate in the Senior CIT program; however, campers must register to participate. In addition, Senior CITs will be provided with a certificate documenting their volunteer hours, in case they need to meet a community service requirement.
- If anyone entering college would like to apply for a counselor position, please email your résumé to sarahbketcham@yahoo.com. Sarah will forward your résumé to the camp director.

### **Out of town guests:**

- Visits are limited to three days for any one individual, unless your guest is staying with you for more than one week.
- Advance written notification to Nancy Conlon, the camp director, is required.
- The camp waivers / releases must be signed by the parent/guardian of the guest prior to attending camp.
- Guests of campers are limited to homeowners of Bay Hills only (for example, grandchildren of BHPOA members who are attending camp are not permitted to bring guests).
- Payment must be made before the guest attends camp. Checks must be from a BHPOA member; cash is also accepted.

**BAY HILLS BEACHCOMBERS  
GROUP DESCRIPTIONS**

<b>Junior Camp: 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.</b>
<p><b>MINNOWS</b> The Minnows need to be 3 years of age by May 1, 2021. <b>They also need to be potty trained.</b> NO EXCEPTIONS. The children in this group will participate in a wide variety of games, arts and crafts, music, sand play, nature projects, and swimming.</p>
<p><b>STARFISH</b> Starfish are 4 years of age. This group will participate in the same types of activities as the Minnows, but geared to the children of this age. They will be under the West Pavilion along with the Starfish, but will have their own counselor. This enables the 3- and 4-year-olds to interact when appropriate.</p>
<b>Senior Camp: 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.</b>
<p><b>SEAHORSES</b> Children entering Kindergarten. This group will participate in a program of arts, crafts and music. Swimming, tennis, and other physical activities will also be a part of their daily routine.</p>
<p><b>DOLPHINS</b> Children entering 1<sup>st</sup> grade. This group will participate in nature study, art projects, music, tennis, swimming, and organized cooperative sports.</p>
<p><b>PORPOISES I</b> Children entering 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. This group will experience a program that includes tennis, swimming, sports, art, music, and organized games.</p>
<p><b>PORPOISES II</b> Children entering 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. This group will experience a program that includes tennis, swimming, sports, art, music, and organized games.</p>
<p><b>SHARKS</b> Children entering 4<sup>th</sup> grade and up. Traditionally, these older Beachcombers have an enriching and entertaining summer session. They also engage in an advanced level of tennis and sport games.</p>
<p><b>C.I.T.</b> Our successful CIT (counselor-in-training) program will be offered to members' children entering the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade. CITs learn to be assistant counselors by working with senior counselors and the younger Beachcomber groups. CITs will also participate in swimming, tennis, and other physical activities.</p>
<p><b>SENIOR C.I.T.</b> The Senior CIT program is offered to high-school age children. The program is intended to provide the group with responsibility in a work-like atmosphere. This is a volunteer position. There is no charge to participate in the Senior CIT program; however, campers must register to participate. In addition, Senior CITs will be provided with a certificate documenting their volunteer hours, in case they need to meet a community service requirement.</p>

***Assumption of Risk, Waiver of Liability, and Hold Harmless Agreement  
Relating to Coronavirus/COVID19***

I, and on behalf of myself and my minor child \_\_\_\_\_ (**list names of all children**) for whom I have the capacity to contract, hereby acknowledge and agree to the following:

The novel coronavirus (hereinafter “COVID19”), has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. I understand the hazards of COVID-19 and am familiar with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) guidelines regarding COVID-19 (*see* <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-nCoV/index.html>). I further acknowledge and understand that that the circumstances regarding COVID-19 are changing from day to day and that, accordingly, the CDC guidelines are regularly modified and updated and I accept full responsibility for familiarizing myself with these updates.

In furtherance of New York State and CDC Guidelines in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Bay Hills Beachcombers Camp (hereinafter “Beachcombers”) has initiated numerous preventative measures and enhanced cleaning protocols (collectively “Protocols”) at Beachcombers. I acknowledge and understand that despite these Protocols, Beachcombers cannot guarantee that you or your child will not become exposed to, contract, and/or spread COVID-19 while attending Beachcombers. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, attending Beachcombers or entering the Beachcombers premises could increase you and/or your child’s risk of exposure to or contracting COVID-19.

**ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I have read and understood the above warning concerning COVID-19. I acknowledge and fully assume the risk of illness or death related to COVID-19 for myself and on behalf of my minor child arising from being on the premises and participating in Beachcombers. Notwithstanding the risks associated with COVID-19, which I readily acknowledge, Beachcombers is of such value to me (and my child) that I accept the risks associated with COVID-19 and hereby willingly choose to have my child participate in Beachcombers.

**INDEMNITY WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY:** I (on behalf of myself and any minor children for whom I have the capacity to contract, representatives, heirs, executors, administrators, trustees, beneficiaries, successors, and assigns, separately and jointly) hereby forever **INDEMNIFY, RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE** the Bay Hills Property Owners Association, Inc., Beachcombers, their owners, officers, directors, agents, insurers, attorneys, volunteers, board members, employees, independent contractors, representatives, heirs, executors, administrators, trustees, beneficiaries, successors

and assigns (the “RELEASEES”) from any and all manner of actions, causes of actions, claims, sums of money, damages, demands, suits, debts, judgments, losses or expenses of any nature whatsoever (including, without limitation, attorneys’ fees, costs and disbursements) arising from the actions, omissions, and/or events stated herein, whether known or unknown, contingent or not contingent and accrued or unaccrued or arising from or out of, or relating to, directly or indirectly, exposure, infection, and/or spread of COVID-19 or any other illness or injury, in any manner, arising during the 2021 Beachcombers program held from on or about June 2021 through August 2021. I, and on behalf of my child, represent and covenant that neither I nor my child has and/or will institute, participate in or assist with any legal arbitral proceeding or regulatory proceeding with respect to the claims released herein, unless otherwise provided by law.

This Agreement and the provisions contained herein shall be construed, interpreted and controlled according to the laws of the State of New York.

**I HEREBY KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY WAIVE ANY RIGHT TO A JURY TRIAL OF ANY DISPUTE ARISING IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THIS WAIVER WAS EXPRESSLY NEGOTIATED AND IS A MATERIAL INDUCEMENT TO THE PERMISSION GRANTED BY RELEASEES TO ME AND MY BEACHCOMBER MEMBER CHILD TO BE PERMITTED ON PREMISES AND PARTICIPATE IN BEACHCOMBERS.**

**I ACKNOWLEDGE AND REPRESENT THAT I have carefully read the foregoing Assumption of Risk, Wavier of Liability, and Hold Harmless Agreement Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19 and fully understand it and freely and knowingly assume the risk and waive any and all rights described above. I agree that this form shall be binding on me, my minor child and other family members, heirs, executors, representatives, and estate: and**

**I FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGE AND REPRESENT THAT** in consideration of my minor child entering Beachcombers premises and participating in camp, I accept and agree to the full contents of this Agreement, I certify that I have the authority to sign on behalf of my minor child and to make decisions for such minor child. I also agree to RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNIFY, AND DEFEND the RELEASEES from all liabilities and claims that arise in any way from any injury, death, loss, or harm that occurs to my minor child arising from or out of, or relating to, directly or indirectly, exposure, infection, and/or spread of COVID-19 or any other illness or injury, in any manner, during the 2021 Beachcombers program. I voluntarily sign as my own free act and deed; no oral representations, statements, or inducements, apart from the foregoing written agreement, have been made; I am at least eighteen (18) years of age and fully competent; and I execute this Agreement for full, adequate and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by same.

**COVID-19 Health Screening Agreement**

For the health and safety of our campers, New York State health officials require campers be screened for symptoms of the novel coronavirus/COVID-19 (hereinafter “COVID-19) before entering summer camps (<https://ocfs.ny.gov/main/news/2020/COVID-2020Jun26-Day-Camp-Summary.pdf>). We require that you keep and review the Daily Health Screening, attached hereto and specifically incorporated by reference herein, prior to sending your child to Beachcombers Camp (hereinafter “Beachcombers”).

By signing this form, I am committing to screening my child by using the Daily Health Screening document on days in which Beachcombers is in session for the 2021 season. I also understand that it is my responsibility to contact Beachcombers if my child is not attending camp based on potential COVID-19 symptoms. **By sending my child to camp, I am actively affirming that the Daily Health Screening has been reviewed by me/the child’s parent/guardian and the results of said screening presented NO answers that indicate or suggest a COVID-19 related status that would prevent the child’s attendance at Beachcombers (e.g. an answer of “Yes” to any inquiry).**

I further voluntarily agree that Beachcombers may monitor my child for symptoms of COVID-19 and may take my child’s temperature upon arrival to Beachcombers on a daily basis to ensure the child does not have a temperature of 100.0 degrees F or higher. I understand that should symptoms develop while my child is in the care of Beachcombers, my child will be immediately separated and I must make arrangements to have my child picked up within one (1) hour of Beachcombers notification of same. Additionally, I will immediately notify Beachcombers if I become aware of any person with whom my child has had contact exhibits any symptoms or has tested positive through any type of diagnostic test. I agree Beachcombers has the right to notify any individuals who may have been exposed should my child require quarantine or test positive through diagnostic test. Beachcombers may require a written clearance from a medical professional before my child may return to participation in Beachcombers. I further understand and voluntarily agree that non-compliance with the safety procedures and protocols stated herein, including but not limited to daily health screenings pursuant to the attached Daily Health Screening, may result in suspension and/or expulsion from the 2021 Beachcombers camp at the discretion of the Beachcombers camp Director.

Please complete the form below indicating: (1) your understanding and agreement to the above terms; (2) your understanding and agreement to perform the Daily Health Screening on your child on the days in which Beachcombers is in session; and (3) your further understanding and agreement that the act of sending your child to camp is an active affirmation that the Daily Health

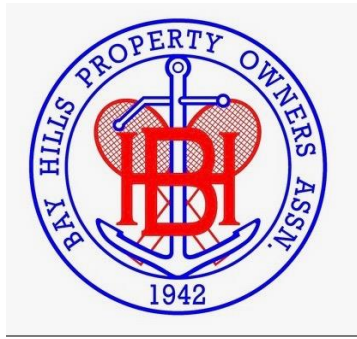

**Daily Health Screening**
